

REGISTRATION GUIDE



IMPORTANT FIRST STEP IN THE PROCESS!

We suggest printing our **REGISTRATION GUIDE** to have at your fingertips during the registration process. The guide will include some instruction, dates, prices, and program options, discounts, bus information, a hard copy of our waiver form, sample program schedules, theme day information, and a what to bring to camp packing list.

Here are some points to note that will help you during and after the registration:

1. **PLEASE NOTE: Our office hours are posted on our web site in the CONTACT US section. We have a seasonal office that responds to e-mail only from November 1st to March 1st. Please e-mail us during these months for the best result.**
2. **Basic Instruction** - Read each point, question, and section of the registration during the registration carefully and answer in detail.
3. **Waivers/Policies** - All parents/guardians please note that the General Waiver of Liability and Medical Forms are all done online within our online registration system. When you sign and or check the check box inside of these forms, you are agreeing to all of the terms within each of the forms you are e-signing, as well as to all of our policies.
4. **Important Downloads** - Please download all the documents you require from our FORMS AND DOCUMENTS page of our web site.
5. **Discounts** - We have two discounts of which you can take advantage. We have an EARLY BIRD DISCOUNT (only available in December and January, and a VALUE BUNDLE DISCOUNT. This discount has very specific criteria so please read all about it on the Registration page of our web site to see if you qualify. This discount requires the discount code that you will find on the DATES AND RATES section of our web site, this code must be entered into each camper's discount code field within STEP 2 of the registration process.
6. **Confirmation** - If you can not login to the system and see your registration – confirmation – and invoice within 24 hours, please contact the office to ensure you are registered.
7. **Receipt** - You will be able to log in to the system to access your receipt any time. Please keep track of your login information.
8. **Buddy Requests** - Please note that Buddy Requests are requests only, and not guarantees. There is a very specific criteria for buddy requests so please be sure to read all about that in the Parents Handbook prior to entering an invalid request.
9. Listed below are your **PAYMENT OPTIONS:**

OPTION 1: Pay in full via cheque or money order. This payment method is offered before April 30th of each camp season. Send us a current dated check or money order upon registration for the total amount of your registration. Cheque or Money Order must be received within 5 business days of your online registration being placed. Payment in full with a cheque may not be a deferred payment.

OPTION 2: Pay in full via credit card. You will be directed to our payment gateway to pay in full during the online registration process.

OPTION 3: Payment Plan. A payment plan option is offered only if you register before April 30th. 25% Deposit will be taken via credit card upon registration. Payments for the balance of your payment plan will be made using post-dated cheques. Please take your balance owing and divide it into 2 equal payments – one for May 1st for and the other for June 1st. These post-dated cheques will need to be mailed to our office within 5 of your online booking. If you have registered on a payment plan after April 15th you will mail 1 post dated cheque with the entire balance remaining for June 1st. Thank you.

CANCELLATION POLICY

2.14. Cancellation Policy – If you cancel prior to April 30th you will receive a refund minus a single charge per camper of \$25.00 for administration of the cancellation. If you cancel May 1st or thereafter you must provide us with 21 days' notice of cancellation in order to qualify for a refund. If you do give us 21 days' notice you will receive a refund minus a service charge of \$25.00 per week per child. Our goal is to process all refunds within one month of the date of the request. If you have not gotten your refund within this time-frame please do contact our office for follow up.

Cancellation of optional programs can only be done as follows:

- In order to cancel **offsite trips (Rockwood Canoe, Treetop Trekking), the Full Week Catered Lunch, or Play with Clay** you must contact our office via email at least 21 days prior to the start of the session in question.
- In order to cancel **pizza orders, Main Event, or Rock Climbing**, you must contact our office via email at least 7 days prior to the start of the session in question.
- Cancellation of a registration that includes a support worker may not be eligible for a refund for the fees charged for the addition of a support worker who has been hired to provide support. Please contact the office for further information about this aspect of our cancellation policy.

KIDS INC. BUS SCHEDULE

Please make note of the following points:

1. You must choose your bus ROUTE and STOP NUMBER upon registration. You will only be able to select one ROUTE and STOP NUMBER per session.
2. You must fill in your permitted adults for pick up and drop off authorization on your Household form during your registration. This area can also be a place to tell us that your campers may walk home if they are 10 years of age or older.
3. Please permit 15 minutes buffer time after your scheduled bus time as our buses are subject to traffic and other situations that can get us off schedule. The only exception to this is stop #1 of any route. This stop has extra time built in in both the AM and the PM for your convenience. If you need a pick up and drop off times that you can count on please choose stop #1 of your route.
4. Our bus will only wait 2 minute past the scheduled bus times prior to moving on to the next stop – therefore we suggest being at your stop prior to the scheduled time.
5. Please do not try to deal with any administration or ask any questions of our bus staff. Please contact our office to deal with all of this. This will help us to keep our buses on time. Thank you!

This General and Medical Waiver of Liability pertains to all campers registered within your family registration. By checking the check box and adding your name to the signature box, you are agreeing to all of the policies within this form and within our PARENTS' HANDBOOK for all registered campers in your family profile.

POLICIES AND CODE OF CONDUCT

On behalf of myself and on behalf of all children on whose behalf I am registering as participants for programs at Kids Inc, I agree to all policies of Kids Inc and understand that we are all held accountable to the Code of Conduct. I understand that all policies and the Code of Conduct are listed in the Parents' Handbook and that policies not listed may be added as required.

OFF SITE TRIPS AND SPECIAL ACTIVITIES

On behalf of myself and on behalf of all children on whose behalf I am registering as participants for programs at Kids Inc, if I have chosen to register said participants in Rock Climbing, Main Event, Tree Top Trekking, or Canoe Trip, I understand the risks involved in each of these program options.

BUS SERVICE

On behalf of myself and on behalf of all children on whose behalf I am registering as participants for programs at Kids Inc, if I have chosen to register said participants for bus service, I understand the risks involved in this service.

EXTRA CARE

On behalf of myself and on behalf of all children on whose behalf I am registering as participants for programs at Kids Inc, I understand that if my camper has any pre-existing condition(s) requiring extra care, I must communicate such requirements prior to said participant's attendance in the program. If such a need is determined after the program has started, there may be additional costs and/or Kids Inc may need to refund me for the remainder of the registration if they are not able to accommodate.

NUT FREE/ALLERGY ALERTS

On behalf of myself and on behalf of all children on whose behalf I am registering as participants for programs at Kids Inc, I understand that Kids Inc works to be a nut free environment; however, we cannot guarantee that your camper may not come into contact with nuts or other allergens. I understand that I am not to send nut products to camp with my camper. I also understand that I may receive email allergy alerts in some cases, to keep me in the loop about very serious allergy issues at camp that I may want to consider when packing lunches and snacks.

FACILITIES

On behalf of myself and of all children on whose behalf I am registering as a participant for programs at Kids Inc, I agree that there is a risk involved in participation in active programs at each off site facility where camp day trips take place. I also agree to the same risk at the camp facility itself. I agree that, when required, I will sign all additional forms and waivers for each additional facility/activity in which my children will be participating during registration for Kids Inc Camp. I understand that participating at any recreational activity facility may lead to injury.

PHOTO/VIDEO

On behalf of myself and of all children on whose behalf I am registering as participants for programs at Kids Inc, I agree that photos and video will be taken during camp and maybe used for promotional purposes and/or posted on social media.

E-MAIL COMMUNICATION/INFORMATION/NEWSLETTER

I understand that by registering for Kids Inc Camp I agree to be on the e-mail distribution list for all e-mail communication, information, newsletters and more. If at any time I wish to be removed from this e-mail distribution list I must contact the admin office to remove myself from the e-mail list.

GENERAL WAIVER

On behalf of myself and on behalf of all children on whose behalf I am registering as participants for programs at Kids Inc, I hereby give permission to have staff of Kids Inc administer or arrange for any emergency medical care, including but not limited to hospitalization if necessary. I hereby consent on behalf of myself and behalf of all children on whose behalf I am registering as participants for programs at Kids Inc to the administration of such emergency medical treatment as may be deemed necessary in any circumstance that may transpire while said participants are in attendance at Kids Inc. All participants are responsible for their own medical coverage. Additionally, on behalf of myself and on behalf of all children on whose behalf I am registering as participants for programs at Kids Inc I hereby release Kids Inc, its officers, its directors, its agents and its employees from all liability, whether direct or indirect, and hereby waive all claims, demands, and actions I have or may have against Kids Inc, its officers, its directors, its agents and its employees for any damages, costs, and expenses, including but not limited to stolen or lost property, personal injury, and allegations of negligence, breach of statutory duty, or negligent misrepresentation, arising from or connected with participation in any activity contemplated by this registration. I hereby indemnify Kids Inc, its officers, its directors, its agents, and its employees from and against any claims that may be made against Kids Inc, its officers, its directors, its agents and its employees by a third party. I have read and understood the program and activity content, and I understand the risks associated with participating in a recreational outdoor day camp program, the policies, terms and conditions listed on the web site, Parents' Handbook, and within this form. Please note: You will formally sign, date, and agree to this waiver during your registration process.

You will be e-signing and agreeing to this waiver and all of our policies listed in our PARENTS HANDBOOK upon registration. Please be sure to inform yourself of all points within this document and the PARENTS HANDBOOK. Thank you!

WHAT TO BRING TO CAMP

When preparing to send your child to camp each day please keep the following policies and the daily checklist in mind!

- Please label all of your child's belongings (both first and last name.)
- No electronic devices (including, but not limited to: cellphone, iPads) may be used from 9:00AM to 4:00PM.
- Please do not provide your child with a cell phone and phone number in order to check in with you during the day unless this is discussed with the camp office prior to your campers attendance. This can cause confusion for the children, our staff, and our policies. We will call you if your child needs to get in touch with you. If you have any concerns in regards to this policy please call our office - and/or if there is a need to deviate from this policy please contact us to discuss.
- We only hold lost and found articles for a maximum of one week. Items that are damaged will be discarded.
- Kids Inc Camp is not responsible for lost or stolen items.
- Kids Inc Camp is an outdoor program. It is recommended that you send your child dressed in outdoor play clothes that are easy to wash. Our lost and found is kept outdoors. Please do not send clothing or items with your child to camp that you are not comfortable having them use in our outdoor environment. Expensive clothing, toys, and electronic items are not suitable for camp.
- On certain days the programs may include a special event, activity, or craft that will have additional requirements. These activities are optional. Please visit our website for more information. about the activities scheduled, and special requirements, during the week that your child is attending.
- If your child has medication to bring to camp or any allergy that we need to be aware of, please call our office at 519-855-6074. Please also submit the appropriate paperwork into our office in order to send medication to camp with your camper.

NOTE: If your camper is attending a special off site trip, or optional programs, information and lists of what to bring for these occasions and activities will be e-mailed to you. These lists will also be on the web site forms and documents page for quick and easy download.

- Pack all food and drinks in a cooler bag
- Pack all items in a backpack, which are the easiest bags to carry

GENERAL CAMP THEME DAYS

What to wear: General Campers and LIT's are welcome to dress up to suit the Theme of the week if they wish. Dressing up is not mandatory for General Campers. LIT's are encouraged to dress up. The LIT co-ordinator will discuss dressing up for Theme Days in more detail with your LIT during their orientation.

Will staff be dressed up? YES! Please note that all of our staff do dress up on Theme Day. Will my camper have the same counsellor on Theme Day? In most cases they will not. In most cases your camper will be on a team with a new leader on Theme Day.

Will my camper be with the same group of campers on Theme Day? NO - they will not. On most Theme Days we create teams that include children from all age groups. This gives campers a chance to be with a whole new group of campers! This opportunity is a wonderful chance to make new friends and mix and mingle. It can be a challenging time for campers who do not like changes so you will need to prepare your camper for this reality in advance. Once the day gets started everyone gets lost in the fun and excitement so please remember that although this change can start off as a challenge it always results in a great day for everyone!

What to bring: Even if your Camper dresses up you should send regular camp clothing and all of the daily basics that you send to camp each and every day.

What will they be doing? Campers will participate in challenges that all have to do with the theme of the day. Theme Days have many traditional activities and challenges. For example: What would our Survivor Theme Day be without the gross eating challenge? How about our giant slide, dunk tank, and jumping castle on our Carnival Theme Day? All of these and more will be a part of our Theme Days for years to come!

Will there be a prize? YES! There is one prize for the winning team. We also focus for the whole day on important things like team spirit, leadership within the team, staying motivated no matter what the score is, and helping our fellow team mates. It is a great day of fun and teamwork!

Why is there no Theme Day on week 1 or 6 in General Camp? Weeks 1 and 6 are 4 day weeks. On these weeks in order to get all of the regular camp activities and cabin group challenges into our daily schedule

JUNIOR GENERAL CAMP THEME DAYS
