

KIDS INC. BUS SCHEDULE 2023

PLEASE NOTE THAT THIS OUR BUS SCHEDULE HAS CHANGED IN THE LAST FEW YEARS BUT IS THE SAME SCHEDULE THAT WAS USED IN 2022. IF YOU HAVE NOT VIEWED OUR SCHEDULE SINCE PRIOR TO 2022 PLEASE REVIEW IT IN ORDER TO ENSURE THAT YOU ARE SELECTING THE CORRECT BUS STOP CODE THAT YOU WILL ENTER DURING YOUR REGISTRATION.

Please make note of the following points:

1. You must choose your bus ROUTE and STOP NUMBER upon registration. You will only be able to select one ROUTE and STOP NUMBER per camper and per session and this stop will be used both AM and PM by your family. You may not use both BUS and CAR TO CAMP. You may only use one of these options so please ensure that you select the one that will suit the needs of your family the best or email us to discuss your situation so that we can assist in further explaining your options.
2. You must fill in all of your permitted adults for pick up and drop off authorization on your Household Form during your registration. This area can also be a place to tell us that your campers may walk home if they are 10 years of age or older. Please add all adults including those who would be helping in the case of emergency or special events.
3. Please permit 15 minutes buffer time after your scheduled bus time as our buses are subject to traffic and other situations that can get us off schedule. This is especially true on the first day of any given session. The only exception to this is stop #1 of any route. This stop has extra time built in in both the AM and the PM for your convenience. If you need a pick up and drop off times that you can be sure will be the most accurate on a daily basis please choose stop #1 of your route.
4. Our bus will only wait 2 minutes past the scheduled bus times prior to moving on to the next stop – therefore we suggest being at your stop prior to the scheduled time.
5. Please do not try to deal with any administration or ask any questions of our bus staff. Please do not enter the bus and please try to help us expedite loading and disembarking the bus by doing so quickly and simply and following all instructions from our bus staff. Please contact our office to discuss any matters that require our attention rather than discussing with our bus staff. This will help us to keep our buses on time. Thank you!
6. Please note that there are occasions that present us with situations that are outside our control with a transportation service. If we encounter traffic, mechanical issues, or other delays that might put our bus behind schedule we do our best to reach out to you via email, text, phone call, and social media while we are working to resolve the issue.
7. Bus Stops on each route are only used when campers are registered at each stop. If you have missed the bus at the stop you were scheduled to use please contact our office to find out where you can catch the bus if it is still in your area. Missing the bus may lead to a situation that requires you to drive your child to the camp program for the day if you wish for them to attend.
8. Each route is named after an animal or insect in order to make it a little more memorable for your camper. Each camper will be given a “bus band” for their backpack that has a corresponding colour and image of the animal or insect that relates to their bus. This will help our staff and your camper feel confident when it is time to go to the bus each day. Please do not remove the bus band from your campers bag. Thank you!

Former Route A**

We no longer have Bus Route A in the same way that it was offered in the past - however - some stops from Route A can now be found on Route C. You are also welcome to call or email our office and we can help you to select a stop that might work for you.

Former Route B**
