IMPORTANT STEP IN THE REGISTRATION PROCESS

The following is a list of points to note that will help you during and after the registration process:

1. **CREATE AN ONLINE ACCOUNT** - In order to book with us you will need to create an online account in our registration system. All that you will need in order to do this is to have an active email address. Simply use the "Register Now" button on the website to get to the registration website OR use this link provided here:

SPECIAL NOTE: Please enable the texting SMS feature in your family profile so that we can communicate with your family with the greatest ease. This texting feature is used when there are schedule changes, and last minute communications that we need to get to you quickly so please consider enabling this feature upon booking. Thank you.

2. **FOLLOW ALL ONLINE INSTRUCTIONS** - The following flow chart will give you more information about each step of the registration process:

Enter Household Details - Enter Each Campers Details - Select Programs and Options - Complete Forms - Select Payment Method

Each step will have instructions for you to follow and it is important that you follow all of the instructions that you are given along the way. One item that you will need on hand that you might not have by your side is your campers health card number and so you might want to grab that before you begin. You will need to know what program you are booking for, what dates you wish to book, and the method of transportation that you would like to book for your camper. If you are not clear on any of these details you are welcome to visit our website to learn more prior to booking so that by the time you login to the system you have all of the details of your booking organized. At a certain point during the registration process you will be asked if you would like to use a discount code. You may only enter and use a discount code if you qualify for its use based on the description of the discount in question. The system will not reject discount codes automatically as it is not able to identify improper use of the code automatically - however - our administration team will review each discount code that is used and remove discount codes that have been used inappropriately. There is no

need to use a discount code if you do not qualify for it since we also have a sliding scale discount available to families in financial need. If you need to ask for a sliding scale for your registration fees due to financial challenges we are pleased to have that conversation with you. Please email us to discuss this sliding scale option if you are in need and only use discount codes if you qualify for them - thank you!

3. WAIVERS/POLICIES - Please note that the General Waiver of Liability and Medical Forms are all done online within our online registration system. When you sign and or check the checkbox inside of these forms, you are agreeing to all of the terms within each of the forms you are e-signing. When you register online you are also agreeing to all of our policies so please read the Parents Handbook located on our [FORMS AND DOCUMENTS](#) page of the web site..

4. IMPORTANT DOWNLOADS - Please download and/or access online all of the documents you require from our [FORMS AND DOCUMENTS](#) page of our web site. Including our Parents Handbook, Bus Schedule, Waivers and this Registration Guide.

5. DISCOUNTS - PLEASE NOTE THE FOLLOWING IMPORTANT INFORMATION ABOUT DISCOUNTS:

- a) YOU MAY ONLY USE A DISCOUNT CODE IF YOU QUALIFY FOR THE USE OF THAT DISCOUNT BASED ON THE DESCRIPTION PROVIDED AND THE REGISTRATION IN QUESTION.
- b) PLEASE NOTE THAT ONLY 1 DISCOUNT CAN BE USED AT ANY GIVEN TIME. YOU MAY NOT APPLY DOUBLE DISCOUNT CODES OR USE MORE THAN ONE DISCOUNT.
- c) PLEASE NOTE THAT YOU MUST APPLY THE DISCOUNT CODE DURING THE REGISTRATION PROCESS IN ORDER TO GET THE DISCOUNT IN QUESTION. IF THE CODE IS NOT APPLIED THE DISCOUNT WILL NOT BE APPLIED.
- d) PLEASE NOTE THAT IF A CODE IS ENTERED AND THE DISCOUNT APPLIED TO A REGISTRATION THAT DOES NOT QUALIFY IT WILL BE REMOVED AND YOUR BALANCE OWING WILL BE RE-CALCULATED.

We have two volume based discounts that can be used for families who are registering who qualify for their use based on their registration. Please find the codes and read more about our 2 available discount codes on our [DATES and RATES](#) page of the website or you can read more about these discounts in our Parents Handbook found on our [Forms and Documents](#) page of the website.

6. CONFIRMATION/RECEIPT/ONLINE PORTAL - You will get a confirmation email after you register and/or you can login to our system any time to review your registration. If you can not login to the system and see your registration – confirmation – and invoice within 24 hours, please contact the office to ensure you are registered. You can download your family statement as a receipt for your records and for your taxes. Login anytime to review, and add to your file! Please use this link provided here: <https://kidsinc.campbrainregistration.com/> - Please note that cancellations and changes need to be done through our registration office via email in order to document the information in writing. In this case please email us at registration@kidsinc.ca

8. BUDDY REQUEST - Please note that Buddy Requests are made on your “Camper Form” in the forms section of the online registration process. These buddy requests are then reviewed in the spring and we do our best to make every buddy match possible - however - there are some limits. Age differences of more than a year, or campers being registered in incorrect sessions, or in different programs can inhibit our ability to make a buddy match. You are

welcome to email the office to follow up on your buddy request at any time. Please note that we will send an email with regards to the status of your buddy request if there is a problem prior to your campers attendance at our program so please stay tuned to your email as we get closer to the camp session in question. 9. PAYMENT OPTIONS:

OPTION #1 - PAY IN FULL

THIS OPTION ALLOWS YOU TO PAY IN FULL WITH AN EFUNDS TRANSFER WITHIN 5 DAYS OF YOUR ONLINE REGISTRATION BEING MADE, OR BY USING ECHEQUE OR CREDIT CARD.

Efunds transfer payments will need to be completed and posted to your file within 5 days of the online registration. If you anticipate any kind of delay please email us in order to avoid cancellation.

Credit card payments are subject to a 2.4% service charge from the credit card company and eCheque payments are subject to a 1% service charge from the bank so please consider using eFunds payments in order to avoid this charge.

EFUNDS TRANSFER - registration@kidsinc.ca - no password required but please add a note with your campers full name in order to help us to apply the payment to the appropriate file.

ECHEQUE - You may pay in full with your bank account by using an eCheque, however, there is a 1% processing surcharge from the bank for using this method of payment. Please consider using Interac eFunds transfer if you want to avoid the service charge.

CREDIT CARD - You may pay in full with your credit card, however, there is a 2.4% processing surcharge from the credit card company for using this method of payment. Please consider using Interac eFunds transfer if you want to avoid the service charge.

The payment amount should be the entire balance owing for the season and needs to include HST.

OPTION #2 - PAYMENT PLAN

Payment Plans can only be organized by using a Credit Card or an eCheque method of payment. Once you select your method of payment that method of payment will be used for your entire payment plan. Please remember that there is a 2.4% service charge for the use of credit card payments and a 1% service charge for the use of eCheque payments and so the eFunds option is the most economical way to create a payment plan.

DEPOSIT - Your deposit will be for 25% of the total of the entire registration amount.

POST DATED PAYMENTS - Your post dated payment dates will be based on the date that you have started your payment plan. Here are some examples of our payment plan dates:

If you book with us in the month of February or March your future dated payments will be May 1 and June 1, however if you book with us a little later in the season your future dated payments might be May 15 and June 15 OR your future payment may be done in one payment rather than 2. Please confirm the dates for your payment plan payments upon booking.

OPTION #3 - SLIDING SCALE AND CREATIVE PAYMENT PLANS

Please note that at Kids Inc Camp we do have a sliding scale for our registration fees for families in financial need. We would love to have the chance to talk to you about how we might be able to help your campers attend our program. Please email us at registration@kidsinc.ca today to discuss.

Please note that we are able to create payment plans that break your payments into smaller amounts if that is a strategy that might help your campers attend our program. Please email us at registration@kidsinc.ca today to discuss.

10. CANCELLATION POLICY

If you wish to cancel we require 21 days advance notice of the cancellation prior to the start date of the session or sessions in question.

Without this 21 day notice we are not able to provide you with any form of refund.

With this 21 days notice or more there will be a refund minus a cancellation fee of \$30 per week per child.

If your cancellation does not provide us with 21 days notice but is approved by our administrative office and is accompanied by a doctor's note that is able to be provided to us we can switch your registration to another session of the same camp season pending availability. Please ensure you communicate with us at registration@kidsinc.ca quickly if/when you require to communicate about this topic.

NEXT STEPS

Now that you have read some of our information and tips related to registration you are ready to go! Make sure that you have selected the dates of the sessions that you would like to book for and that you know what session corresponds to the dates you would like to book for, select your method of transportation from our options of car to camp - regular hours, daily bus transportation, or car to camp - flex hours, and check in to see if you will be eligible to use any of our discount codes. If you are using our daily bus transportation please ensure that you have viewed our bus schedule and that you have selected your bus route and bus stop number. Here are some examples:

In this example there is a family with 2 campers from Acton who will be booking for 6 sessions total and using the camp bus as their method of transportation to and from camp each day: This family would like to book for the week of July 6 to 10, Aug 10 to 14, and Aug 24 to 28 and there are 2 campers that will be booking. This means that they will be booking for Session 2, Session 7 and Session 9 and that they will be booking for a total of 6 sessions of camp and therefore will be eligible for the VALUE BUNDLE discount. This family also knows that they will be using the bus service and they live in Acton Ontario and therefore the bus information they will need is as follows: Bus Route E - Bus Stop #7.

Please use our dates and rates chart and our bus schedule that follows to gather all of the information that you will need in order to proceed with the next steps of your registration.

NOW THAT YOU ARE BOOKED

Welcome to Kids Inc Camp for the 2026 season! We are so happy that you booked with us and we can't wait to see your camper/s soon. Please note that you will get a confirmation email from us and if you selected to pay with an Interac eFunds transfer please proceed to do that within 5 days of booking. You will get forms sent to you as we get closer to the camp season for you to complete in your online registration portal for your campers so please stay tuned for this communication to come your way. If you entered a Buddy Request we will be in touch if there is anything in the way of our ability to make that match for you and/or you are welcome to follow up with our registration office. You will get an email from us the weekend prior to your camper/s attendance in our program each time they are booked with us. This pre-camp email will have information about the upcoming session of camp and will also include our list of what to send to camp with your camper. Here is a copy of the list of what to pack for a successful time at camp so that you can get ready prior to the camp season!

WHAT TO BRING TO CAMP

****PLEASE SEND ALL CAMPERS WITH SUNSCREEN AND BUG SPRAY ALREADY APPLIED - WE WILL PROVIDE TIME FOR A PM APPLICATION - HOWEVER - IT NEEDS TO BE PRE-APPLIED IN THE AM. PLEASE NOTE:** If your family does not use sunscreen or bug spray please email our office so this can be added to your file - thank you

1. All items are best packed in a backpack
2. PLEASE LABEL all items you are sending to camp
3. Full lunch every day of the program (this is only not required on Friday if you have paid for Pizza Lunch)
4. Snacks (morning and afternoon) or money for our "snack shack" if your camper is in General Camp or our LIT program. ****Junior Campers do not** have access to "snack shack" and so you must pack them with 2 snacks.
5. Full water bottles and plenty of beverages - although water can be refilled at the fountain we encourage you to send all of the water your camper will need for the entire day as we are on well water and most campers prefer water from home. Please send LOTS of water with your camper for the very best hydration.
6. Sunscreen pre-applied in the AM and in their bag for re-application in the PM (we recommend pump, roll on stick or spray if your camper has more difficulty applying) If your family does not prefer that we help them with sunscreen please email our office so that we can add a note to your file.
7. Bug spray pre-applied in the AM and if you would like them to reapply this in the PM please put it in their bag labeled with their name. If your family does not prefer that we help them with sunscreen please email our office so that we can add a note to your file.

8. Closed running **shoes** are a MUST!!!! These are mandatory for sports and running games, this is an absolute must every day at Kids Inc. Please note that if your camper does not have closed running shoes they will be excluded from some activities for safety purposes. PLEASE NOTE - Although crocs and keens are “closed toe” they are not closed running shoes....we have found that these choices of footwear are not safe for walking and running on the uneven surfaces in our forest and on our sports field. No crocs or keens in the forest or the sports zone - closed running shoes only.
9. Sun hat or hat with a brim and sun shirts and sunglasses can be helpful too!
10. Bathing suit and towel (if you like they can wear their bathing suit to camp in the morning to make changing easier) - this should be sent every day for all campers in all programs unless you have discussed with the camp office that you would not like for your camper to participate in aquatics. If this is the case and you have not yet communicated that to our office please do so now.
11. Swimming goggles and nose plugs are optional.
12. Swim shoes/sandals are optional but are very helpful at the Kids Inc pond!
13. Quiet before/after hours activities like a book or a back pocket game can be helpful for campers who are using any amount of our longer regular hours or our flex hours (optional)
14. Change of clothing if there is any reason that this might be required (This is especially for Junior Campers)

IN CLOSING

We want to thank you once again for your booking with us at Kids Inc Camp and remind you that we are here to help you at the registration office anytime you need a hand. The way to reach us during the off season is to send us an email at registration@kidsinc.ca and we will respond as quickly as we can. If you would like to book a time for a phone call where we can help you with the registration process over the phone step by step we can do that too!
